Furloughs

- Are to be taken between 5/31 and 6/20, unless you have been exempted.
- Supervisors and/or managers should confirm your furlough week via email or memo.
- You are **NOT** to work during this week.
- You should <u>not be working</u>, checking emails or answering messages during <u>your</u> furlough week. If supervisors are making suggestions that you should be "available, on-call or present" during your furlough week please contact the USA Office at <u>usa@umass.edu</u>
- If your supervisors are denying requests for time off (vacation, sick, personal) during the 3-week furlough period, please contact the office. Requests should not be unreasonably denied. You cannot take accrued time during YOUR furlough week.
